Nomination Submission Questions:

- Ideal nominees will embody the "3 E's" of Sustainability. Describe how your nominee is working to ensure the 1) Environmental health, 2) social Equity and 3) Economic prosperity of San Mateo County (sub-headings are encouraged).
- If your nominee excels in one of the 3 aspects of sustainability (e.g. social equity) describe how your nominee goes above and beyond others in their field; what make them an exceptional leader?
- Nominees are encouraged to have an established track record. If your nominee is new in their work, demonstrate what steps/measures have been taken to ensure the longevity of their project or organization.
